1. Overall Board Examination Results & Academic Profiles

The academic session 2025-26 concluded with magnificent breakthroughs in the Class X and Class XII Board Examinations administered by the CBSE. Through meticulous weekly assessments, targeted remedial interventions, and special weekend mentoring clinics, our students achieved a flawless percentage in class X.

2. Academic Distinction Highlights:

- **3 STUDENTS** secured the top 10 rank among 125 Vidyajyoti school in the CBSE Class X Board Examination with an outstanding aggregate of above 90% in 2025-26 earning special commendation from the State Education Department.
- **Miss Diya Banik** emerged as the school topper in the Class X Science stream with 96.8%.
- **Tripura Talent Search Examination (NTSE):** 5 students successfully qualified for the state-level tier, marking the highest count from an English Medium state government school in Khowai.

3. Dedicated Efforts in Environment Education

Conscious of the ecological vulnerability of our region and aligned with the national *Mission LiFE* (Lifestyle for Environment) parameters, the school Eco-Club has undertaken institutional transformations over the 2025-26 cycle:

- **The Green Canopy Initiative:** Students across Classes IX-XII successfully planted 100 locally indigenous saplings (including Agar wood, Teak, and seasonal fruit plants) along the outer perimeter of the Durganagar campus.
- **DNA Club:** Around sixty Students of VII-XII are engaged in the DNA Club. Students actively participated in different activities areas like institutional and filed work.
- **Roof-Top Rainwater Harvesting:** Supported by the local PHE wing, a functional rain catchment framework was finalized. Collected water is directly repurposed for school sanitation and garden maintenance, reducing municipal dependence by 40%.
- **Zero-Plastic Compliance Zone:** Single-use plastics were fully banned from the campus premises. The school cafeteria transitioned to biodegradable leaf plates and bamboo-infused items manufactured by rural self-help groups.
- **Organic Kitchen Gardening:** A highly scientific compost pit project was initialized by our science wing. Mid-Day Meal waste is actively transformed into fertilizer to sustain

our integrated kitchen garden, cultivation from which supplements the students' daily lunch layout.

4. Sports Achievements & Physical Education Milestones

At KGEMHSS, sports are treated as an foundational pillar for leadership development. Our athletes have scaled remarkable heights in Sub-Division, District, and State-Level Tournaments organized under the school sports calendar:

- **Khowai District Sub-Junior Football Championship:** The school's Under-14 Football team bagged the Runner up Trophy 205-26.
- **Traditional Sports Promotion (Thang-Ta & Yoga):** Regular expert coaching camps were organized. One student **Mrs Asmita Das** participated in national level **Thang-Ta** competitions.
- **Annual Sports Gala:** The multi-day internal meet was executed in January 2026, promoting near-total student inclusion through localized athletic relays.

5. Institutional & Pedagogical Innovations

To remain at the absolute vanguard of the Vidyajyoti Mission mandate, the school rolled out a sequence of tactical institutional and structural innovations throughout the year:

- **Smart Classroom Integration:** Three standard classrooms were augmented with high-end interactive projection panels and synchronized digital content kits, enabling immersive audio-visual conceptual maps for Science and Mathematics subjects.
- **Foundational NIPUN Tripura Hub:** An innovative, activity-linked primary play-lab was established for Classes I to III, utilizing localized wooden counting toys, script-cards, and targeted learning kits to cement early-stage literacy.
- **The Tinker-Lab Framework:** Weekly STEM exploration hours were appended into the middle-school routine, letting students directly tinker with introductory electronics, basic mechanical gears, and simple open-source code modules.
- **Language Lab Activation:** To scale up spoken English proficiency across rural demographics, specialized speech-assistance interactive modules were set up to elevate pronunciation and vocabulary benchmarks.

6. Parent-Teacher Association (PTA) Activities

The active partnership between our faculty and guardians forms the foundational bedrock of school administrative stability. The PTA convened four formal general body meetings during 2025-26 with an exceptional average turn-out of 85%:

- **Academic Report Card Clinics:** Standard post-examination structural parent-teacher consults were conducted. Individual progress lines, health logs, and targeted attendance shortfalls were co-reviewed dynamically.
- **Mental Health & Digital Wellness Seminars:** Organized in tandem with mental healthcare counselors from Khowai District Hospital, special sessions were put forward to sensitize parents on managing digital screen-time limits and board-exam stress profiles.
- **Community-Led Remedial Circles:** A unique initiative where localized educated guardians volunteered to assist struggling students through structured group-study hubs outside school operational timings.

7. Major Policy Decisions of the School Management Committee (SMC)

The School Management Committee, under joint leadership from public administrative representatives, senior guardians, and faculty heads, ratified key structural resolutions to elevate security, resources, and welfare:

- **Complete CCTV Coverage:** Approved the formal allocation of institutional expansion funds to implement a 16-node high-definition CCTV surveillance array across deep corridors, main gates, and high-value laboratory blocks to assure maximum child safety.

- **Drinking Water Facility Upgrades:** Voted for the installation of an advanced multi-stage commercial RO filtration plant coupled with industrial water coolers to deliver safe drinking water across both primary and senior academic blocks.
- **Boundary Structural Reinforcement:** Moved an administrative request forward to the local PWD office for the immediate repair and height elevation of the primary pucca boundary wall alongside the eastern fringe of the campus.
- **Special Skill Labs:** Sanctioned a dedicated structural room to be remodeled into a computer coding lab starting from the upcoming 2026-27 session.
- **Centralized sound system:** Sanctioned centralized sound system for each room.
- **Inverter Facility:** Sanctioned inverter whole school building.

8. Looking Ahead

Khowai Government English Medium Class XII School enters the upcoming academic year with renewed systemic vigor. Backed comprehensively by the Directorate of Secondary Education, the Vidyajyoti program, and our local community, we pledge to relentlessly reach toward the highest standard of holistic educational excellence.
